Troparion after the Great Doxology: When you rose from the tomb and broke the fetters of Hades, you abolished the sentence of death, O Lord, and thus delivered all men from the snares of the enemy. Appearing to the apostles, you sent them out to preach, and through them, bestowed your peace upon the world: O you Who alone are full of mercy!
